American Structurepoint has completed the renovation of **Loeb Stadium** for the City of Lafayette, Indiana. This facility replaces the historic Loeb Stadium built in 1940 and is home to the Prospect League's Lafayette Aviators and the Lafayette Jefferson High School baseball teams. This design takes inspiration from the stadium's original 1940sera, Art Deco architecture and stands on the same historic Columbian Park site in downtown Lafayette.

By rotating home plate 180 degrees and lowering the playing field by seven feet, American Structurepoint designed the open concourse stadium to provide clearer sightlines for spectators and better accessibility to nearby Columbian Park attractions.

To create a more flexible and hospitable environment, American Structurepoint included key features in the design, such as a variety of seating types—1,910 chair-backed seats in the lower bowl and three enclosed suites in the upper level—and new amenities like a press box, party decks, and synthetic turf.

The reimagined Loeb Stadium excels as a modern, accessible, and stylish community venue and is definitely a destination attraction for Lafayette visitors.
