American Structurepoint is improving safety and easing traffic congestion on a busy section of a major highway in the Cinncinati area. We served as lead design engineer for Walsh Construction Company on this phase of the I-75 Mill **Creek Expressway** project that included interstate widening and ramp improvements. More than 160,000 vehicles travel this portion of I-75 every day.

The project widened I-75 to four lanes in each direction between the Hopple Street and Mitchell Avenue exits and improved the I-74 ramps to I-75.

American Structurepoint engineers designed 3.5 miles of roadway, four bridges, five retaining walls, and new highway lighting. Our work included the design of new stormwater and wastewater systems installed under two nearby railroad lines. We also worked closely with the contractor to develop a work zone traffic plan that ensured safety for both traffic and the contractor during construction.

In addition, American Structurepoint provided land surveying and environmental services for the project. Construction will be completed in August 2022.
